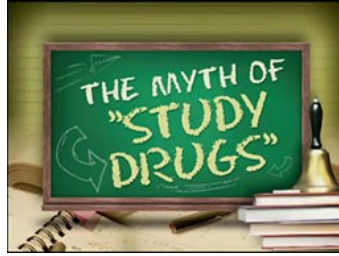

## **2 Substance Abuse Contact Hours Offered**

We hear lots about performance-enhancing drugs in sports but how much have you ever heard about drugs some people think can enhance academic performance? Kids probably know about them and what they think could be dangerous. The medications are designed to treat Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder, known as ADHD, but many teens and young adults think of them as "study drugs." The misuse of these prescription stimulants is part of the bigger problem of prescription drug abuse and the misconception that pills – even if they belong to someone else -- must be safe because a doctor prescribed them. Learn about the scope of this problem and how it spreads from middle school, to high school, to college.

### **KEY CONCEPTS:**

- Who is using so-called "study drugs"
- Find out about the dangers of prescription stimulant misuse and diversion
- Learn what the research says about these drugs and the potential for other risky behavior
